Example of need and how funds could be allocated

Bereavement Group

Group counselling designed to help people come to terms with the loss of their loved ones. The group is open to six/eight clients and will run continuously over six weeks (costs cover payment for a professional counsellor and room hire) = £1,925.00.

Survivorship Counselling

Group counselling designed to help people come to terms with the fact that they have had cancer and are now well. (costs cover payment for a professional counsellor and room hire) = £1,800.00.

Therapies

Currently we offer 25 treatments per week to clients (ranging from massage, hypnotherapy, reflexology, acupuncture, reiki, chiropody. Whilst some of the therapists offer their services free of charge, unfortunately this is not possible for all. The cost of delivering services for four clients each week (208 clients per annum) = £5,200.00.

Night Sitting

Helps the patients fulfil their wishes of staying at home for as long as possible, also allows the carer to receive a good night's rest. Currently night sitting services cost £140 per night and we estimate we will provide the services an average of four times per month = £6,720.00 per annum.
